

Get a **FREE** Naloxone (Narcan) Kit!

What is it?

Naloxone is a medication that can reverse an overdose that is caused by an opioid drug (i.e. prescription pain medication or heroin).

How does it work?

When administered during an overdose, naloxone blocks the effects of opioids on the brain and restores breathing within two to eight minutes to prevent death.

Where can I get it?
